Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in Clinical Psychology, shall be a 60 credit program, include at least 12 courses from the following catalog, and must include DPSY999 Thesis Preparation and Presentation. Candidates may select one of three degree paths: 1) Behavioral Analysis, 2) Counseling Psychology, or 3) Psychoanalysis. Electives from any program in the college may be taken to complete the course credit requirement.

New Program! Psychoanalysis: The PhD program in Psychoanalysis offer students a cutting edge curriculum and prepare them through interdisciplinary study for scholarly research, teaching or augmentation of professional practice. While social scientists and scholars in humanities and cultural studies are becoming increasingly interested in the psychoanalysis of culture and in the cultural analysis of psychoanalysis, very few institutions of higher education provide an arena for such interdisciplinary undertaking. This program was developed to fill the gap for such critical pursuits. Its distinct mission is to promote systematic dialogue between psychoanalysis, critical social theory, and cultural analysis.

Core and elective courses provide a solid foundation in theory and methods needed for the systematic integration of **psychoanalysis**, critical social theory, and cultural studies. The distinctive character of the program is its emphasis on crafting new theoretical and methodological links between **psychoanalysis**, the social sciences, the humanities, and cultural studies and applying an interdisciplinary lens to psychological and cultural phenomena.
