Bachelor's Degree in Theology

Requirements: You need a High School Diploma or equivalent documentation in order to enter the undergraduate program.

For the Bachelor of Art in Theology you are required: 125 semester Hours in order to graduate. This include 33 credits hours of study fitting to the Prevalent Education Prerequisite, this includes the prescribed number of units, in the fields of the following courses.

English (6 units); Written & Oral Communications (3 units) Natural Science (6 units); Mathematics (6 units); Social Science (6 units); Humanities (6 units)

Therefore, the student must be certain to finish an attainable amount of 33 semester hours while enrolled at St. Albert's College & Graduate School.

Master of Arts in Theology

Requirements: The student must have a Bachelor of Arts in Theology in order to be accepted into the graduate program for the Master of Arts in Theology. In order to obtain the M.A. in Theology, the student must take a total of 30 credit hours and write a major research paper of at least 50 pages in length OR take a total of 39 credit hours (completing three additional courses instead of writing the research paper).

Doctorate in Apologetics and Theology

Requirements: The student must have a M.A. in Theology or Religion Studies. For the Ph.D. in Apologetics and Theology you need to complete 42 Credit Hours.
